Fees For Personal Injury Cases

LEGAL FEES Q & A:

Do you charge for the first meeting at Thompson, Thompson & Glanville?

No, not for personal injury matters.

How much will the legal work cost me?

At the initial consultation, I will discuss your situation and go over your options. With my help, you can then choose the best course of action for you. I will then provide you with a fee agreement describing my services and the fee that will be charged. This will either be a contingent fee of 33 1/3% for all of the legal work, or an hourly fee. The choice is yours. If you choose to hire me on a contingent basis, the law firm will first subtract our costs from the recovery. Then the law firm will charge an attorney fee of one-third of the net recovery. If there is no recovery, there will be no attorney fee.

The law firm will advance costs for investigation and the law suit. The Client will be responsible for reimbursing the law firm for all such advanced costs from and to the extent of any recovery. If there is no recovery, the Client is not held responsible for any advanced costs.

Hourly Fees for Personal Injury Work:

If you choose to hire the firm on a hourly basis, a retainer must be paid in advance of the firms taking the case. Each staff member involved in a given matter keeps track of his or her time which is billed at a predetermined rate. The normal hourly rates charged for personal injury work by each staff member are:

*Work is billed in increments of .1 hour, with a minimum of .2 hour for each activity.
